2.2.1 Kristopher Andrew Maguire

Mr. Maguire is a 27 years old , British national with seven (7) years experience in the electrical trade . He is applying for a wireman license and will be employed by Hay Electric Ltd. He has submitted along with his application a curriculum vitae , (4) four certificates of qualification and (2) two letters of recommendations .

Decision

It was resolved to **approve** the issuance of a **temporary wireman license** subject to the following conditions:

1. The applicant is employed by, and works for **Hay Electric Ltd.**
2. The licence is valid for the duration of the applicant's work permit and must be renewed as per section 58 of the Electricity Regulations (2005 Revision).

2.3 Electrician

2.3.1 David William Anderson

Mr. Anderson is a Canadian national with (7) seven years of experience. He is applying for an electrician license and will be employed by Alba Electrical Contractors, Mr. Anderson's work permit application is in the process of being submitted and Alba wants to ensure that they will be able to obtain an electrical license for him before bringing him to the Island on a successful grant of a work permit. He also submitted (4) four certificate of qualification and (3) three reference letters with his application.

Decision

It was resolved to **approve** the issuance of a **temporary electrical licence** subject to the following conditions:

1. The applicant is employed by, and works for **Alba Electrical Contractors**.
2. The licence is valid for the duration of the applicant's work permit and must be renewed as per section 58 of the Electricity Regulations (2005 Revision).
3. This licence is not recognized for the purpose of regulation 60 of the Electricity Regulations (2005 Revision).

2.3.2 Marico Tan Hubahib

Mr. Hubahib is a Filipino national with (10) ten years of experience. He is applying for an Electrician License and will be employed by G.E. Electrical Maintenance Services Ltd. He has been employed by Peleme Ltd. From April 27, 2004 until February 5, 2006 as an electrical wireman at the Ritz Carlton, Grand Cayman. Mr. Hubahib has been a valuable part of Peleme Ltd. He has submitted along with his application (3) three certificates of qualification and (4) four letters of recommendations.

Decision

It was resolved to **approve** the issuance of a **temporary electrical licence** subject to the following conditions:

1. Provide a current copy of the Trade & Business license. This licence shall be verified by the Secretary of the EBE.
2. The applicant is employed by, and works for **G.E. Electrical Maintenance Services Ltd.**
3. The licence is valid for the duration of the applicant's work permit and must be renewed as per section 58 of the Electricity Regulations (2005 Revision).
4. This licence is not recognized for the purpose of regulation 60 of the Electricity Regulations (2005 Revision).

The requirement of item 1 above shall be satisfactorily addressed prior to issuing the temporary electrician licence.

2.3.3 Kerry Dean Reynolds

Mr. Reynolds is a Canadian national with (28) twenty-eight years of experience . He is applying for an temporary electrical license and will be employed by Corporate Electric Ltd. Mr. Reynolds has been in the electrical industry since 1980 and has worked in many facets of the electrical trade. He graduated from Mohawk College in the trade program in electrical construction and maintenance in Ontario, Canada and received his electrical trade qualifications in May 1981. This is the equivalent of an electrical license in Canada.

Decision

It was resolved to **defer** the issuance of a **temporary electrician licence** for the following reason(s):

1. The EBE requires proof that the applicant holds a current electrical licence that satisfies regulation 61 (9) of the Electricity Regulations (2005 Revision).
2. The EBE requires a minimum of two work references stating where the applicant acquired his experience and the length and extent of his experience as noted in regulation 57 (1) of the Electricity Regulations (2005 Revision). These references shall be current within the past two years.

2.3.4 Darren C. Carroll

Mr. Carroll is a American national with (25) twenty -five years experience . He is applying for an electrician license and will be employed by Alba Electrical Contractors. He has submitted along with his application (7) seven certificates of qualification and (2) letters of recommendation. Unfortunately, he cannot supply a reference from his current employer at this stage as he needs to wait for his work permit approval before submitting his resignation. Mr. Carroll's work permit application is in the process of being submitted, and Alba wants to ensure that they will be able to obtain an electrical license for him before bringing him to the Island on a successful grant of a work permit.

Decision

It was resolved to **defer** the issuance of a **temporary electrician licence** for the following reason(s):

1. The EBE requires proof that the applicant holds a current electrical licence that satisfies regulation 61 (9) of the Electricity Regulations (2005 Revision) or proof that the holder of an electrical contracto's licence requires a current electrical licence.
2. The EBE requires a minimum of two work references stating where the applicant acquired his experience and the length and extent of his experience as noted in regulation 57 (1) of the Electricity Regulations (2005 Revision). These references shall be current within the past two years. A resume would also be helpful.
3. Provide positive proof of identification. Some documentation submitted has two different surnames.

4.0 Exam/Licensing Matters

4.1.1 Anthony Caswell Brown

Attached is an application form together with supporting documentation for the Board's consideration for the issue of an electrician's license for Mr. Brown. Mr. Brown is a Jamaican national with Caymanian Status, (a copy of his approval letter is attached for reference) and is currently working since March 23, 1999. He has 10 years of experience in the electrical field as a licensed wireman (#W-053). Mr. Brown recently passed the Cayman Islands Journeyman Electrician's exam proctored by the International Code Council, Inc. with a score of 75.00% (see Statistic Report on file). Mr. Brown has proven himself to be dependable, knowledgeable and dedicated employee. Androgroup Ltd. support his application for an Electrician's license and states that. Androgroup Ltd. request the Board's favourable consideration to his application.

Decision

It was resolved to **approve** the issuance of a **electrician licence** subject to the following conditions:

1. The applicant is reminded of section 60 (1) and (2) referenced below.


60 (1) The applicant shall not trade, contract or carry on business as an electrical contractor of any nature or employ staff for any work unless licenced in that behalf by the Electrical Board of Examiners and also holds a licence as an electrician or contractor under the Trade and Business Licensing Law (2003 Revision).

(2) Qualification for an electrical contractor's licence shall be that the applicant is the holder of, or whose business is managed and supervised by the holder of, a valid licence under regulation 61(1)(a), (b) or(c) for a period exceeding two years immediately preceding the date of the application and who satisfies the Board that he is a suitable candidate for such licence.


