1. This licence is subject at all times to the requirements of regulation 60 of the Electricity Regulations (2005 Revision).
2. Any changes to the company connected to this licence shall be submitted to the EBE for review.
3. This licence is subject to any condition(s) imposed in respect of the applicant's licence issued under regulation 61.
4. This licence shall expire one year from the date of issuance.

Please be advised that any unlicensed workers in your employ may be eligible to sit the wireman exam under regulation 61 (9A) of the Electricity (Amendment) Regulations 2009 (copied below). Please also be advised that all unlicensed electrical workers are in violation of regulation 59 of the Electricity Regulations (2005 Revision).

**61 (9A)** The Board shall, upon the application of any person, permit that person to sit the Electricians Trade Test if –

(a) immediately before the date of commencement of the Electricity (Amendment) Regulations, 2009 that person was not licensed under this regulation; and

(b) at the time of the application, that person is in the employment of a licensed electrical contractor, and, where that person meets the qualification requirements to be licensed, the Board shall grant a temporary licence (that is, a licence that allows that person to hold it during the currency of the occupation he is engaged in at the time he makes the application and that application is granted).

**5.3.2.** Merlin Jones Welds has submitted along with his Electrical Contractors' application, a cover letter, list of licenced employees, two references letters and a copy of his Trade & Business License to carry out the business of Electrical Services.

**Decision**

It was resolved to **approve** the issuance of an **electrical contractors' licence** subject to the following conditions:

(b) at the time of the application, that person is in the employment of a licensed electrical contractor, and, where that person meets the qualification requirements to be licensed, the Board shall grant a temporary licence (that is, a licence that allows that person to hold it during the currency of the occupation he is engaged in at the time he makes the application and that application is granted).


